Exchange of Notes Between Poland and Japan

(extract) 2023.3

- With a view to <u>supporting the Ukrainians taking refuge in</u> <u>the adjacent countries and reduce the burden of the</u> <u>receiving countries</u>, the Government of Japan has decided to extend humanitarian assistance in the countries concerned.
- In order to address the above, the Government of Japan would intend to introduce a scheme named the "Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects (GGP)" in the Republic of Poland <u>for the maximum of 5 years</u>.

What's GGP?

GGP (Grant Assistance for Grass-roots Human Security Projects) is

- <u>A financial assistance scheme</u> which supports the following projects proposed by such bodies as <u>non-profit organizations</u> <u>and local governments</u>.
- **1.** Projects for socio-economic development such as primary health care, public welfare, environment, etc.
- 2. Projects to improve the well-being of those at grass-roots level
- 3. Small Projects (under 10mil yen (= 314,000zloty))

Eligible Recipients

Any type of non-profit organization

*Except Federal government authorities and Japanese NGOs

*Except NGOs less than two years of establishment


