National Fund

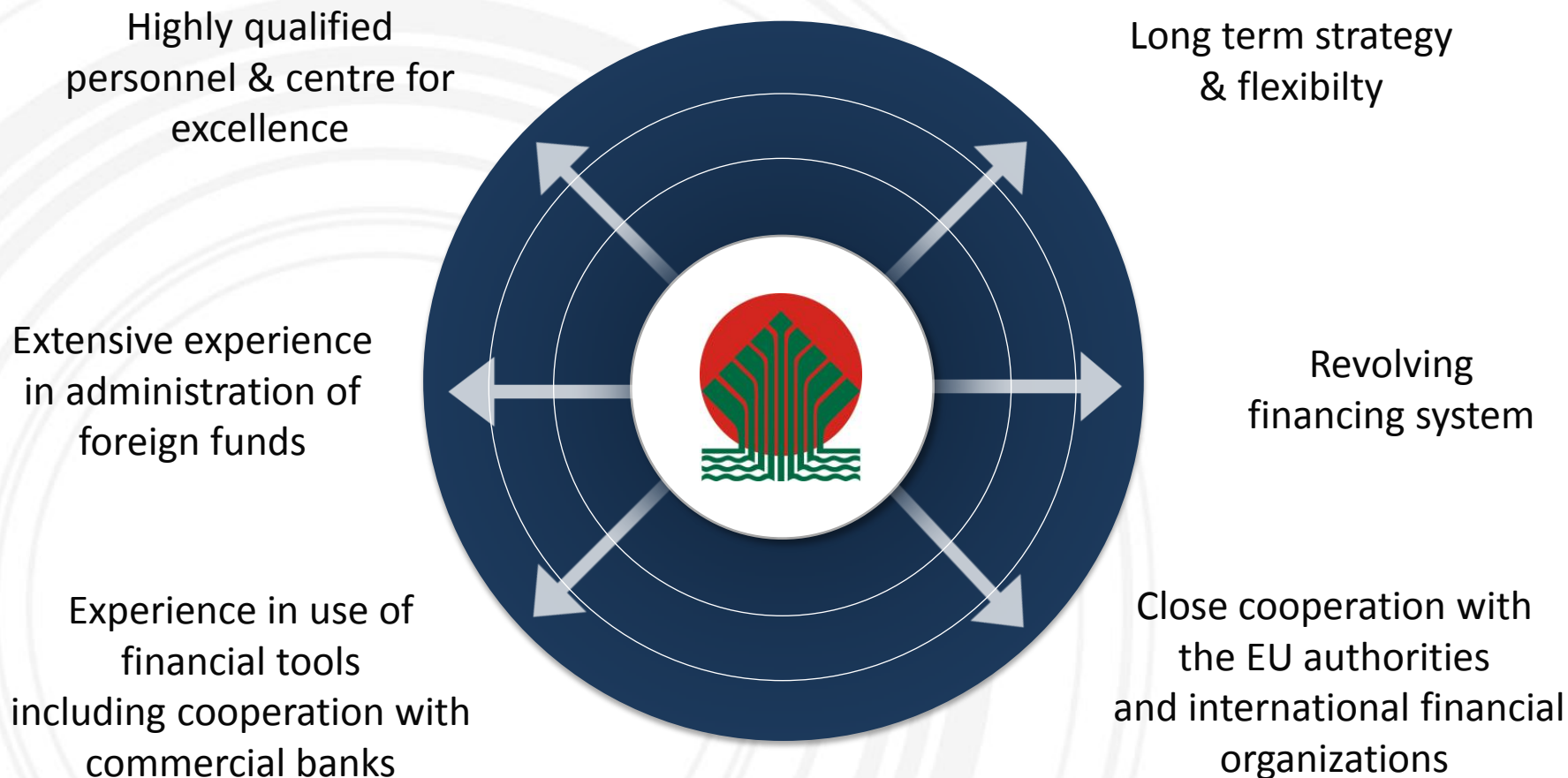
- Established in 1989

GEKON Programme

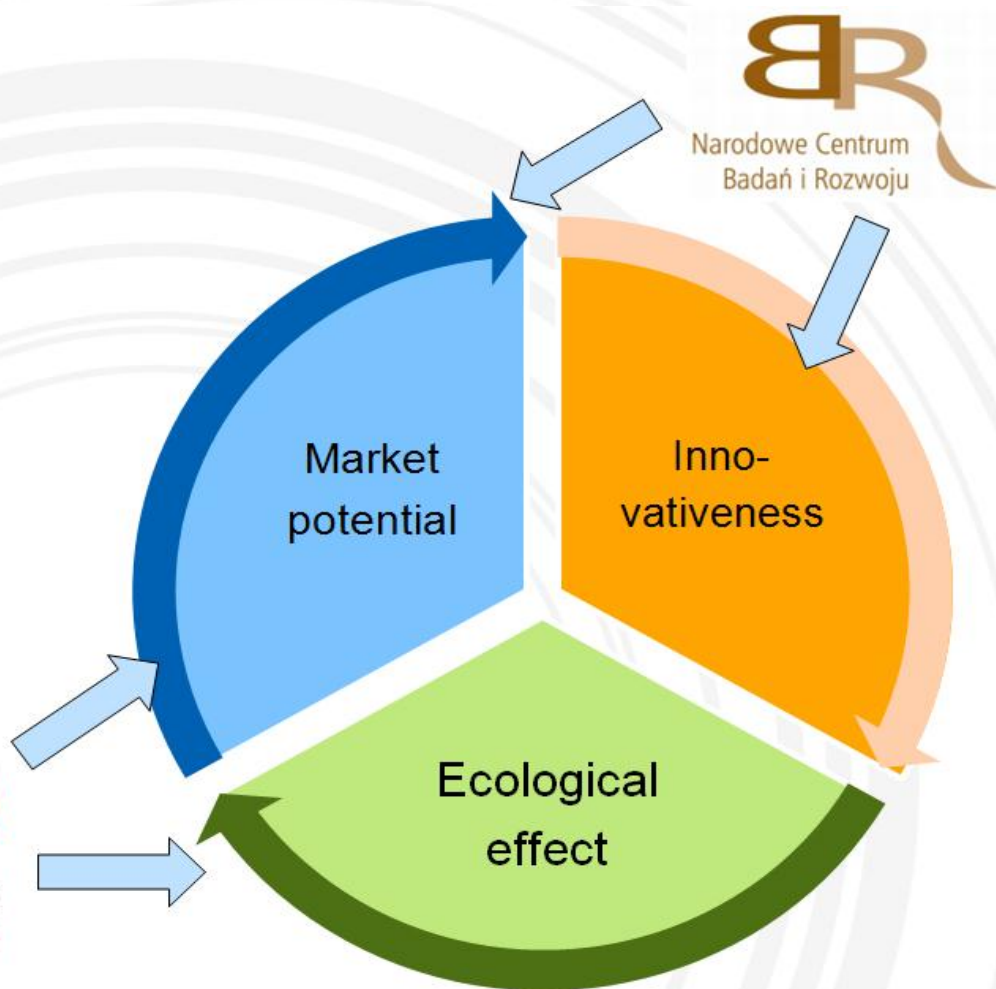


Total budget: PLN 400 millions
